#### Ladies/Gentlemen:

This list of questions and responses is being issued to clarify certain information contained in the above referenced IFB. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions by potential Bidders are not binding to the State, unless an addendum expressly amends the IFB. Noting in the State's responses to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the State of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Bidder.

### 2. Will this IFB be chosen based solely on bottom line price?

**Answer:** Section 5.5.3 of the IFB states that the award will be made to the responsive bidder who submits the responsive bid that is most favorable to the State. That includes a combination of factors, including price and the ability to meet stated delivery timelines and stated specifications.

### 3. Was the IFB details written by Employees of DOIT or a 3rd Party company?

**Answer:** The specifications provided meet the requirement of DoIT and the programs that will use the fiber.
