This Amendment #1 is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above referenced TORFP. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this TORFP. For the following changes/additions, any new language has been double underlined and marked in bold (i.e., **new**) and any deleted language has been marked with a strikethrough (i.e., ~~deleted~~).

1. TORFP Section 3.2.1, Part F, delete this requirement:

~~Resumes for all Master Contractor staff listed in the Overall Master Contractor team organizational chart.~~

2. Attachment 1 – PRICE PROPOSAL, delete in its entirety and replace with the amended version accompanying this Amendment #1. The purpose is to clarify that DoIT will evaluate the Price Proposal based on the “Program Manager” and “Project Manager” labor categories only. Any proposed additional labor categories will not factor into the Price Proposal evaluation. Master Contractors are encouraged to propose additional labor categories and rates based on the best technical approach for performing the TORFP scope of work. Note that Master Contractors will not be able to add labor categories later to suit a need.

This correction is indicated by updates to the Price Proposal form as follows:

- The inclusion of “Evaluation Hours” for the “Program Manager” and “Project Manager” labor categories only;
- The deletion of the “Evaluation Hours” and the “Total Annual Cost” columns for the additional labor categories (i.e., “Labor Category 1”, etc.);

- The addition of lines for “Year One, Year Two, Optional Year Three, and Optional Year Four” for the Project Manager labor category; and
- The modification of text consistent with the above changes.
