## **Questions and Responses to RFR J01B3400007**

Q1. Does the vendor need to be on site 100% of the time or can a schedule be worked out with the state to do a portion of the work off-site?

A. While MDOT may not require that the Master Contractor be on site 100% of the time, it should be noted that site visits to all Transportation Business Units to interview the stakeholders will be essential to the successful implementation of the project.

Q2. Atch 1A seems to ask vendors to provide redundant information as the candidates resume and information provided on Atch 1 but just in another format. Is there any way to combine Atch 1 and 1A into one document? Can you please clarify?

A. Attachment 1 is complete resume information of the resource being proposed. Attachment 1A is the requirement that a Labor Category and candidate relevant experience stating how the candidate meets each requirement.

Q3. Atch 1A – The last box says, “Preferred Experience”, are you referring to two bullets that ask for 3 years of experience with MS Exchange 2007 and 1 year experience with Google Mail and APPs?

A. This is required experience and not preferred.

Q4. Can work on this position be performed partially remotely or 100% onsite presence is required?

Q5. Is there an incumbent on this position?

A. No incumbent for this position.
