Q & A #1

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above-referenced RFR were received by e-mail and are answered below for all potential Bidders. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses are not binding on the State, unless the RFR is expressly amended. Nothing in the State's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or an acceptance by the State of any statement or interpretation on part of the vendor.

Question #1 – Is this for a new position or is there an incumbent contractor currently working on the project?

Answer #1 – This is a new position. There is no incumbent.

Question #2 – Is the position listed in RFR P00B5400101 the same position that was requested in RFR P00B5400087? Or is this for another developer position that will be working on the same project? If it is for the same position, does this mean that none of the candidates proposed in response to RFR P00B5400087 satisfied the minimum qualifications?

Answer #2 – This RFR is not for the same position requested in RFR P00B5400087. It is a new position for the same project.

Question #3 – Is it possible for the interview to be conducted over the phone or Skype?

Answer #3 – According to the CAT+ Master Contract Request for Resume process, candidates meeting the minimum qualifications will be notified for a telephone interview followed by an in-person interview.

Question #4 - How many resumes can be submitted?

Answer #4 - There is only one (1) position being requested. Please refer to RFR Section 4 which indicates Master Contractors may propose only one candidate for the position requested.
