This Amendment #4 is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above referenced RFP. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this RFP. Specific parts of the RFP have been amended. The following changes/additions are listed below; new language has been double underlined and marked in bold (i.e., <u>word</u>) and language deleted has been marked with a strikeout (i.e., <u>word</u>).

- 1. Revise the Section 2.4 Master Contractor Minimum Qualifications (p. 22-23) as follows:
 - 2.4.1 Provide six (6) examples within the past <u>seven (7)</u> three (3) years of IAS or equivalent quality assurance engagements on IT development projects <u>or IT systems</u> for commercial or government entities. The scope of the six (6) examples must include one or more of the following areas of work:
 - 1. IV&V (snapshot or life cycle)
 - 2. Information Systems Auditing and
 - **3.** Quality Assurance
 - 4. Risk Assessment Analysis
 - 2.4.2 At least <u>one (1)</u> three (3) of the examples must have evaluated information system development projects with a project value in excess of \$10,000,000 (i.e. value of the project being assessed by Contractor).
 - 2.4.3 At least one (1) of the examples must have evaluated an information systems development project with a project value in excess of \$15,000,000 (i.e. value of the project being assessed by Contractor).
- 2. Revise the section 3.4.2.6 Section 4 Compliance with Master Contractor Minimum Qualifications (p 61-62) as follows:
