Addendum #1 to the Request for Proposals (RFP) Microwave and Ancillary Equipment and Services Project No. 060B0400006 February 25, 2010

This Addendum is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above named RFP. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this RFP. Specific parts of the RFP have been amended. The following changes/additions are listed below; new language has been underlined and language deleted has been marked with a strikeout (ex. language deleted).

- 1. Revise Section 2.1.3 (General Requirements), as follows:
- 2.1.3 State agencies shall be allowed to return equipment to Master Contractors for any reason within 45 days, unless other arrangements are made between the Master Contractor and the State. Master Contractors shall refund to the State within 30 calendar days of receipt of any returned radio or communications equipment, the purchase price of the returned equipment, including shipping costs. The State shall not be charged restocking fees.
- 2. Replace Attachment D-III Labor Rate Schedule with Attachment D-III revised (2-24-2010).

Please see Attachment D-III revised (2-24-2010) - (a copy is attached to the email promulgating this Addendum)

3. Revise Attachment D (Price Proposal Form and Instructions) on page 47, as follows:

FORM D-III - Functional Area III- Installation, Repair, Preventative Maintenance Services and Manufacturer's Extended Warranty. Offerors are required to record the fully-loaded hourly prices (both straight time and premium time) they are proposing for each listed item. Record the hourly labor rate for all 5 years of the Master Contract for all labor categories.

Offerors are to propose only the labor categories they are capable of providing.

Premium time rates pertain to work performed outside of normal hours (overtime, weekends and holidays).

Offerors will use these labor categories and hourly rates throughout the term of the Contract when submitting a proposal in response to a PORFP for Functional Area III. Proposed hourly rates in a PORFP may be lower but can be no higher than those proposed in this Attachment D. If labor rates are not provided by the Offeror with the response to this RFP, the Master Contractor will not be allowed to propose this labor category in response to future PORFPs.
