Discussion/Remarks

- **Commissioner 1**: What were the exceptions in states with mostly centralized procurement processes?
 - Solomon Kingston: Exceptions to centralized procurement are treasuries and entities outside of the executive branches of states.
- Commissioner 2: Have there been any efficiency studies on centralized procurement?
 - Solomon Kingston:
- Commissioner 3: Centralized procurement and centralized IT may go hand in hand, DoIT needs to have IT procurement oversight in order to truly centralize IT.
- **Commissioner 1**: What was the primary goal of centralization, oversight, cost? What were the metrics of effectiveness?
 - Solomon Kingston: No known metrics, main goal of centralization was oversight
- **Commissioner 2**: How can we move forward large projects forward quickly, does excessive oversight slow projects and lose money?
- **Commissioner** 1: Need to be able to purchase products quickly. Oversight is good, but we need metrics to know if we are improving processes and oversight.
- **Commissioner 2**: IT should be included in construction, transportation and other high priority projects with exceptions or dedicated oversight.
