Guest Presentation: Stu Davis, on experiences helping the State of Ohio Centralize IT:

- Introductions:
 - Stu Davis: former long-time CIO of Ohio and VP at CGI
- Shared Ohio's journey in optimizing IT through improved communication and collaboration.
- Emphasis on optimization as opposed to consolidation

Discussion/Remarks:

- Commissioner 1 inquired about the necessity of legislative backing in Ohio's process.
 - Mr. Davis informed that Ohio completed their optimization without any formal legislative or executive action.
- Commissioner 1 mentioned Major Information Technology Development Projects (MITDP) and their context in the State of Maryland.

Guest Presentation: Denis Goulet, on experience as the CIO in a state with centralized IT:

- Introductions:
 - Denis Goulet: CIO for the State of New Hampshire for 10 years, previously in the private sector in the software industry.
- Presented New Hampshire's centralized approach focusing on cybersecurity and data privacy.
- Emphasized leveraging IT for citizen impact and maintaining synergy with a standardized but adaptable approach.

Discussion/Remarks:

- Commissioner 2 inquired about the current timeline for future developments and legislative efforts for the Modernize Maryland Commission.
 - Commissioner 1 noted that the next centralization meeting will be in November, and the legislative team will be working on write-up in the mean-time.
