## **QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES #2**

Question 2: Please clarify the service levels for pricing the UPS and ancillary equipment maintenance related services. Are prices to include preventative maintenance service visits only, or also include labor and travel for any emergency visits to the sites, and include remedial and corrective repairs, parts, labor and travel (full service)?

Answer: Emergency calls and repairs are billable under T&M on the Fiscal Year PO.

Question 3: Are UPS battery replacements and UPS capacitor replacements to be included or excluded from scope and prices?.

Answer: These replacements will be excluded from scope and prices, and will be under T&M, requiring the submission of a proposal at the time of need to be approved fiscally.

Question 4: What is the age of the UPS' and ancillary equipment?

Answer: DC Plant/Batteries Baltimore-2019. DC Plant/Batteries College Park-2001. UPS College Park-2015/Batteries 2018. UPS Crownsville 2002/Batteries 2016. UPS Annapolis 2000/Batteries 2018.

Question 5: Are any of the UPS' and ancillary equipment still under mfg warranty?

Answer: The Baltimore DC Plant is under warranty. All others are not.

Question 6: If battery and capacitor replacements to be included in prices, what are the age of the batteries and the capacitors in the UPS units?

Answer: All equipment will require quarterly preventive maintenance visits,

four times per fiscal year.

Question 8: Are there 2 PMs on UPS and ancillary equipment (semi-annual and

annual)? How many PMs required on associated batteries?

Answer: One annual PM is needed on all equipment, while the remainder of

visits will be semi-annual PM's. Batteries must be PM'd during every

PM visit.

Question 9: In regards to the living wage requirement included in 4.27A, is the
