down, if warranted, and enter as a percentage.
Multiply the Recommended VSBE Goal as a Percentage times the
Estimated PORFP Value in Section 5, and enter as a dollar amount.

Provide an explanation of any difference between the Calculated
MBE Goal in Section 3 and the Recommended MBE Goal as a
Percentage. Also, provide an explanation of any difference
between the Calculated VSBE Goal in Section 5 and the
Recommended VSBE Goal as a Percentage. For example, multiple
MBE firms exist in the MDOT directory as potential subcontractors,
but some are not available for the PORFP term.
