Review Minutes from 9/12/2023 – Brandon Renehan

Proposed New Limited Primary User:

<u>US Department of Health and Human Services (US HHS) – Represented by Adam Karsin and Avi Stein</u>

This agency was previously approved as an interop user and are requesting to become a Limited-Primary user. The request is for two (2) talkgroups assigned to four of their units: Administration for Strategic Preparedness and Response, Office of Inspector General's Protection Operations Branch, Division of Continuity and Special Operations and Response. The 2 talkgroups would utilize ~100 TDMA radios which are used for internal USHHS responses to emergencies in MD and special operations.

MD FiRST Capacity Impact: Minor depending on location and usage.

Proposed Motion: The System Managers' Committee recommends the Radio Control Board approve US HHS application to become a Limited-Primary User on MD FiRST.

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<u>US CISA, Emergency Communications Division – Represented by Wes Rogers</u>

This is the Federal Emergency Communications Division that has Emergency Communications Coordinators (ECC's), Public Safety Advisors (PSA's) and Cyber Security Advisors within its group to perform MD Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Vulnerability assessments and provide assistance during emergencies. They have ~20 TDMA radios, an MOU with COG and access to all NCR trunked radio systems. They are requesting one (1) talkgroup for use with their PACE and COOP operations and for team coordination during NSSE's and planned emergent events. MD FiRST Capacity Impact: Minor

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WSSC Water Police & Homeland Security – Represented by Ken Hawkins and Chief Bergstrom

The WSSC Water Police protect the watershed of Prince George's, Mongomery and parts of Howard Counties. They are sworn law enforcement officers, area of operation encompasses critical infrastructure for 1,000 square miles and over 6,000 acres of reservoir. They are requesting one (1) talkgroup for use by ~65 TDMA radios for daily operations for officers on patrol.

MD FiRST Capacity Impact: Minor, usage on PG, Montgomery systems is relatively low.

Proposed Motion: The System Managers' Committee recommends the Radio Control Board approve WSSC Water Police's application to become a Limited-Primary User on MD FiRST.

NCRCIG - Represented by Chief Mike Baltrosky and Capt. Matthew Houck

National Capital Region Communications Interoperability Group (NCRCIG) maintains the national radio cache which includes ~1,200 radios, tactical BDAs, repeaters, deployable trunked systems and other interoperable emergency systems that are deployed when any region in the state has an emergency situation or planned event. NCRCIG technical group is responsible for deploying and coordinating the cache and are requesting one (1) talkgroup utilized by ~100 TDMA radios. This talkgroup will be used for communication when managing critical events and coordinating the radio cache/deployable assets.

MD FiRST Capacity Impact: Minor
