Questions/Discussion MD FiRST Operations Status Update – Patrick King

Co-Chair, Andrew Cummins: reiterated that MD FiRST was designed for use by a private entity. It is for government agencies or jurisdictions for use by first responders.

Old Business

The discussion was opened to review lessons learned from the FSK bridge incident. 1.) users and command chiefs are still challenged with getting all fire, police, first reponders getting on the same channel, especially with a mass unplanned event. With the FSK incident, it was not an issue of everyone having the correct channel, the issue was how to communicate to all repsonders that were arriving what channel they should use. Interoperable training at the upper levels would be beneficial. When an event happens and the first group of responders arrives, it is difficult to determine who is in command. The confusion

is around what should the process is for the first few minutes of an unplanned event. How will all responders know what channel to switch to and who is in command?
