- RFP Section 2.7: Insurance Requirements: Delete in its entirety.
- Substitute with amended RFP Section 2.7:

2.7 <u>Amended Insurance Requirements</u>

- 2.7.1 The Contractor shall maintain property and casualty insurance with minimum limits sufficient to cover losses resulting from or arising out of Contractor action or inaction in the performance of the contract by the Contractor, its agents, servants, employees or subcontractors.
- 2.7.2 The Contractor shall maintain a policy of general liability insurance that is of the proper type and of sufficient limits that the State and its officials, employees, agents, servants, guests and subcontractors are reasonably covered in the event of injury or death.
- 2.7.3 The State of Maryland will be named as an additional named insured on the policies of all property, casualty, liability, and other types of insurance evidencing this coverage.

 Certificates of insurance evidencing this coverage will be provided prior to the commencement of any activities in the Contract. All insurance policies must be with a company licensed to do business in Maryland.
