Option #5 Potassium Iodide

Maryland has taken advantage of the National Regulatory Commission to give out K1 packets. They are free if you live within a 10 miles of a Nuclear Power Plant. The Potassium Iodide helps protect your Thyroid Gland in case of exposure to radiation. If you do not live with the 10 miles of a Nuclear Power Plant please contact your local health department or pharmacist. There are 2 different plants: Peach Bottom Nuclear Power Plant and the Calvert Cliffs Power Plant. This option also provides you with your local health department where the power plants are located.
