The Department of Information Technology (“DoIT” or the “Department”) is hereby canceling Solicitation No. 060B8400104, titled *DOMAIN-BASED MESSAGE AUTHENTICATION, REPORTING AND CONFORMANCE (DMARC) SUPPORT SERVICES*, and rejecting all proposals as provided in COMAR 21.06.02.02.C. The Department has determined that the scope of this solicitation no longer accurately represents its needs, and therefore, an award in the best interest of the State cannot be made.

The Department will assess whether it will issue a revised solicitation or employ another business strategy that will satisfy its security requirements. If DoIT issues a revised solicitation, it will be open to all interested parties (subject to the solicitation’s requirements) and posted on DoIT’s IT Bid Board and eMaryland Marketplace Advantage (eMMA).
