
<u>Department of Information Technology (DoIT)</u>: An executive branch unit of Maryland state government, organized according to Maryland Code, State Finance and Procurement Article, § 3A.

<u>Information Technology Project Request (ITPR)</u>: A request submitted by a covered Unit to the Department regarding a proposed information technology project for major IT requests.

<u>Major Information Technology Development Project (MITDP)</u>: Any technology development project meeting the criteria as established in Maryland Code, SF&P Article, § 3A-301.

<u>Policy</u>: A statement of jurisdiction and methods to guide agencies in the management of IT resources and services. <u>Units</u>: All executive branch units of state government, except those identified in Maryland Code, SF&P § 3A-302.
